Make. It. LAST.


#03. Rock kid





Signs are just set dressing, right?



One of them pillaged, robbed and murdered, the other downloaded a music album, basically twinsies!


#26. Trains good

Sure seems like we're putting plastic where it does not need to be.


#29. Those boxers can stand on their own



I mean, with the housing market the way it is, it might be worth it to let it in and charge it rent.


#41. A relaxing shower

But who is this interloper?


#47. Another relaxing shower

Does anything hurt? No? Might be a silent killer, you better watch out.


#49. Validation
